Dear OBYG families,

We have been waiting for this day for a long five years, ever since Superstorm Sandy wrecked our beloved Windswept: **we're going home!** We are excited to announce that the Village of Ocean Beach has restored the old beautiful mansion to a year-round community center, allowing OBYG to return to its cherished bayfront homestead. We hope you will join us as we celebrate this homecoming on Saturday, July 14th. You can even RSVP while you register your child for camp.

And yes, registration is now officially OPEN. The 2018 camp season will run from **June 25th through August 17th** -- sign up for the week, month or whole summer! Please go directly to your parent dashboard to register or visit OBYG.org for more details. We are pleased to offer no raise in tuition this year, and as always, we will offer an early registration discount of 5% off for families to enroll by April 15th. Please note that we will be closed for camp on July 4th this year so we will see you at the parade!

In addition to purchasing tee shirts, backpacks and rash guards when you register, this year you can also purchase discounted packages for after camp drop in classes like wake-boarding, sailing, fluke fishing, morning paddleboard and hip hop. You can find this in "enrollment extras."

We are committed to making the unique OBYG experience available to everyone through our scholarship program. You can download a scholarship application when you register for camp and the entire process is completely confidential. Please contact our offices prior to the first day of camp if you have any questions or financial hardships, and we will be happy to discuss a reasonable plan so your child can participate at camp. We must be contacted prior to June 25 in order to make this happen so don't delay. If your child has any outstanding balance or his or her tuition is not paid, we will be unable to allow him or her to attend OBYG until the account is settled.

Lastly, to comply with the Board of Health regulations, it is mandatory to have an up-to-date medical form on file for each camper before they begin camp. Campers will not be able to start camp without their completed medical forms.
